- 3. The Company defines environmental goals and action plans, including regular reviews and monitoring. Efforts focus on pollution prevention at the source, efficient use of resources, and fostering environmental responsibility among employees and suppliers across all levels.
- 4. The Company communicates SHE & SE performance and policies to both internal and external stakeholders in a transparent and timely manner.
- 5. All levels of management are required to lead by example and allocate appropriate time and budgetary resources to support employee training and awareness in relation to SHE & SE practices.
- 6. All employees must be informed, trained, and comply strictly with the Company's SHE & SE procedures.
- 7. These guidelines shall be enforced not only at the Company level but also across all subsidiaries.
